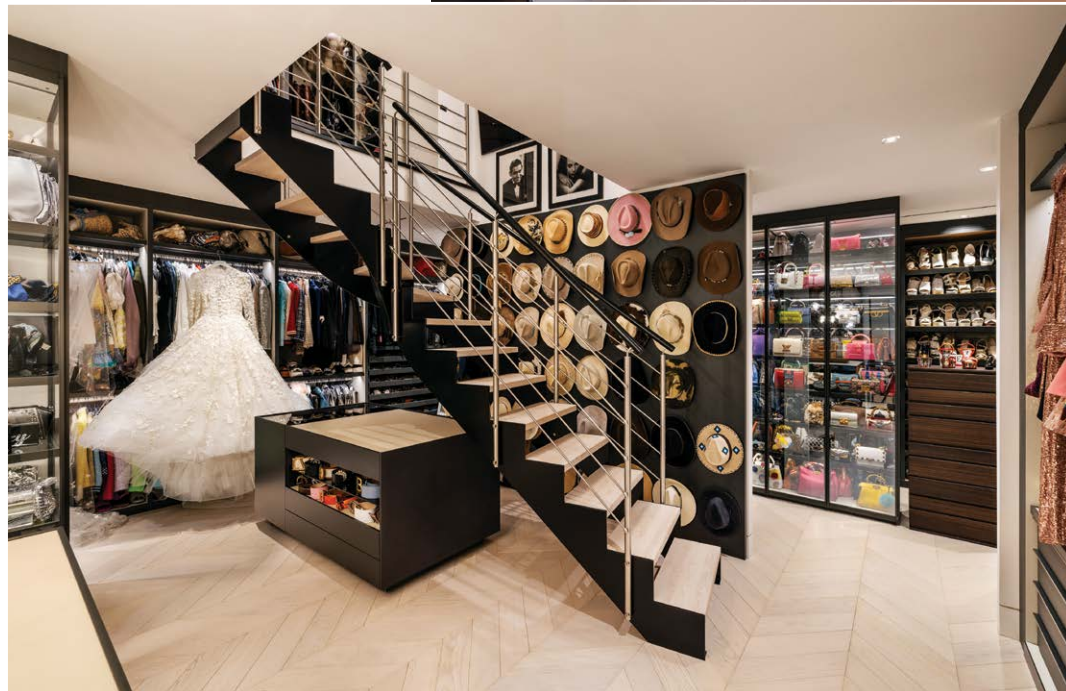

The primary bedroom is what Musser calls “the epitome of custom,” with another Foglie d'Oro wall and ceiling feature (all of it meticulously installed piece by piece). Zanotta's mammoth custom bed spans 164 inches wide with a lavish blue velvet headboard. A fourth Jorge Luis Santos artwork adorns the main bedroom wall, with the rest of the room (virtually all glass) facing the Intracoastal.

“What I love about this location is that we have deep water, a gorgeous sunrise, and afternoon shade at the pool, all with a magical view of the island,” says Musser. “In Palm Beach proper, we would have had shallower water and hot afternoon light in the backyard—those are just two of the little secrets about this enchanting place.”
